

## JANUARY 2026

One year ago, with prayer, faith, and determination, we set a bold goal. We believed God was calling us to triple the number of women we would serve in 2025. By His grace, that is exactly what happened.

Not only did we reach more women than ever before, we saw God move powerfully across every area of the mission. We expanded bed capacity for emergency and stabilization care, creating more space for women to find safety and breathe again. And we began renovations on the Freedom Center, transforming a place once marked for the selling and profiting off of sexual identity and nakedness into a future place of healing, hope, and long term restoration.




